The weekly shows also explore critical social issues like gender-based violence, alcoholism and HIV. An interactive question and answer session at the end of each show gives listeners the opportunity to talk to an expert on ECD, ask questions and even share their own parenting stories.

According to Deputy Minister of Health Dr Joe Phaahla, parents and primary caregivers are at the centre of young children receiving the care they need. With Side-by-Side, the Department of Health is placing itself alongside parents by offering them information and support on the parenting journey.
